

DISEASE PREVENTION ADVOCACY PROJECT

This is a Disease Advocacy Project. The definition of advocacy is the act of speaking on the behalf of or in support of another person, place, or thing.

An example of an advocacy is a non-profit organization that works to help women of domestic abuse who feel too afraid to speak for themselves.

You will act an advocate by educating others on HIV/AIDS. You and your group members will create three types of presentation to inform others about the disease. The presentations will be in the following forms:

Brochure and an Interactive Video.

Power Point or Prezi - You and your group members need to research information that should include but is not limited to:

- Background information about the disease (Basic facts with key information)
- Distinguish whether disease is communicable or non communicable and how it is transmitted
- Identify cause of the disease, (if known)
- What are the signs and symptoms of the disease,
- Indicate what is needed to prevented, treated or cured the disease
- Provide information where to get help.
- What group of people are affected by the disease
- Share how drug use can have an impact on HIV/AIDS
- Include the names of the people in your group.
- Make sure slides can be read from a distance
- Make sure you do not copy information from internet
- Be sure to cite the source of your information.

Brochure Designer use Microsoft Publisher

- Choose a style from the Microsoft Publisher brochure templates
- Add background information about the disease
- Background information about the disease

- Distinguish whether disease is communicable or non communicable,
- Identify cause of the disease, (if known)
- What are the signs and symptoms of the disease,
- Indicate what is needed to prevented, treated or cured the disease
- What group of people are affected by the disease
- What is needed to cure/treat/educate victim of the disease
- Resources where people can get more information or help
- The names of you and your partner, date, period and no(s)
- Share how drug use can have an impact on HIV/AIDS
- Indicate how a persons can use assertive communication and refusal skills to reduce the risk of contracting the disease.

Interactive Video Presentation - Video should include script that tells

- Use Goanimate.com to create your interactive video
- Create a script/dialogue about the Background about the disease. The script should include
 - Cause of the disease (if known)
 - How the disease is transmitted
 - The results of transmission
 - What can be done to prevent the disease
 - Show how a person can use assertive and refusal skills to reduce the risk of contracting the disease
- What is needed to cure/treat/educate victims of the disease
- What challenges are faced by the disease or health care.
- Make the video informative can be entertaining.
